WINS THE PRIZE stalked the early leaders into the turn, rallied three wide into the stretch, dug in late and got up. EMILY'S STAR pressed the pace from the outside, bid around the turn, gained the lead but was outfinished by the winner. HOUSE OF CRYSTAL unhurried early on, raced along the inside, then angled four wide around the turn and surged late. RENEES BEAUTY set the pace while under pressure from outside rival, was unable to match strides but finished gamely. SALLY SILK SOX tracked from just off the pace while racing in the two path, then found the rail and produced a late run. SOTA DE OROS reserved in the early going, angled in to find the rail, then rallied down the lane but was forced to check off rivals heels nearing the wire. RED LOLLIPOP tracked the early leaders, raced three wide into the stretch and failed to produce a rally when asked. SKIMMALICIOUS unhurried down the backstretch, took the turn four wide and was never a factor. MYSTIFING MISS tracked from along the inside, pulled up around the turn and vanned off after..
