Footnotes

TOM'S LIGHTNING was taken off the rail early, moved up outside pacesetter, was fanned four wide entering the stretch, reached front nearing sixteenth marker and kicked clear. CARIBBEAN'S COMIC reserved off the pace, chased from along the rail, continued inside, rallied strongly and gained the place. WARREN'S YODLER quickly stepped to the front, set pressured pace from the inside, lugged out on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, lost command then lost the place late. KENNETH'S WARRIOR was close up early from between foes, stalked on two wide path into the lane and was unfinished. FRIENDLY HALF was forwardly placed from off the rail, caught three deep into the bend, remained on same path and lacked needed late punch. SAFEONTHEWIRE bumped at the start, chased from between foes, continued three then four wide into the stretch and was no late factor. EXOTIC STORY bumped with inside rival leaving the gate, settled outside, chased three wide, came in bit around the turn and never menaced. ANDREW'S COURAGE was bumped in the opening strides, lagged back while angling over, saved ground but was outrun throughout.
