CATIFORNIA DREAMIN prompted the early issue then joined leading pack while three wide, caught four wide exiting the turn, gained slim advantage and held sway from the outside under urging. AROMATICA forced the pace then challenged from between rivals, hooked up in prolonged stretch battle inside winner but missed in game effort. OUT OF SEATTLE tracked leaders from the inside, continued along the fence into the stretch, loomed through the drive and gained third. WUNDERPFERD sped to the front, set pressured pace from the inside, resisted while two wide into the lane but gave ground in the final sixteenth. MARVEL GIRL reserved off the pace, angled over, chased two wide then along the rail and never reached contention. RARE ACTION bumped at the start, settled off the pace and bit off the rail, chased outside rival and failed to menace. GALE SCHOONOVER broke inward and bumped foe, was unhurried from the inside, saved ground but was outrun.
