GOLDEN GAB gained stalking position early, continued four wide into the turn then advanced three wide on the bend, bid nearing sixteenth marker then finally wore down leader late. SEATTLEINSPIRATION dueled three deep early, gained command on the turn, edged away while coming in slightly but could not hold off winner. MISSILETTE reserved from off the rail, chased three wide then between rivals exiting the turn and rallied strongly to best others. OUR LITTLE KITTY chased pace from along the rail then came out slightly leaving the turn, altered course to the inside in upper stretch and finished willingly inside. HYPER LASS contested the early issue from between horses, dropped back on the turn, continued outside same rival into the lane and weakened. HARD EIGHT settled off the pace and bit off the fence, drifted out some entering the stretch and lacked needed late response. DIXIE HAWKS hopped at the break to be off behind the field, taken well off the fence early, chased four wide on the turn then five wide into the lane while outrun. MY SISTER LAUREEN showed good early speed from along the rail, lost contact around the turn, gave way readily in the stretch then was pulled up shortly after the finish and vanned off.
