Footnotes

HANDSOME THOMAS was hustled to the front, set pressured pace while slightly off the rail, came out bit entering the lane, then edged away under steady right hand encouragement on three wide path. SLOKKIE quickly gained pressing position outside pacesetter, forced the issue into the stretch, lost contact in the drive but safely held second. PREPPY PILOT showed good early foot, tracked top pair from the inside, also dropped back bit, then continued along the rail late and lasted for the show. SOMETHING SONIC settled off the pace, stalked from off the rail then outside rival, came three wide into the lane and just missed third. THUNDER ONE reserved early along the rail, shifted out approaching the bend, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly from the outside. SEAFIRE was slow to begin then dropped well back early, chased three wide into the stretch and was no factor. EL NAVIGANTE settled along the inside, saved ground throughout and weakened.
