Footnotes

ANOTHER BOB chased from along the inside, then angled two wide around the turn, then finished well to overhaul foe and hold off GET OFF THE SUGAR in the late stages. GET OFF THE SUGAR reserved early on, rallied four wide around the turn, then flew late but was unable to catch the winner. BEAR CREEK sped clear of the field early, took control of the rail continued to hold the lead into the stretch but flattened late. HUSSLE HOME bumped start, allowed to settle early on, saved ground racing along the rail, then failed to rally when needed. BOMBERO chased while taking the turn three wide, then weakened down the lane. DEPUTY LIGHT broke in and bumped foe at the start, took the turn two wide, then passed tired foes in the stretch. SMOKE TILL DAWN bumped start, showed brief speed but was no match for the early speedsters, then faded around the turn and in the stretch. RIVADEO (MEX) saved ground racing near the rail but never threatened. QUIETLY GO raced four wide into the stretch, never menaced, then was vanned off after.
