TAKE ISSUE was away in good order, rated kindly in the two path, shook off SEATTLE QUAKE and ROYAL FOR SURE nearing the stretch and drove to the win. ROYALETTE was in close down the backside but checked back from tight quarters nearing the turn, then angled in two wide and rallied into the stretch to take the place a sixteenth out. ROYAL FOR SURE was four wide in the early fray, could not match strides with the winner nearing the lane but continued on well through the drive to hold down third money. GIN N' TYCHONIC was put in a tight spot by ROYALETTE entering the lane but recovered well to make a mild late bid along the rail. SEATTLE QUAKE had early foot three wide between rivals only to weaken in the stretch. LEXI'S HABIT passed some tired ones three wide. CITY LIGHTS SONATA made no rally. ONESASSYLUCKYLADY tired after racing five wide. CAPERUCITA ROJA tired after racing far outside.
