EVERYNOW AND THEN bumped at the start but rushed up inside to force the pace, bid inside pacesetter entering the lane, gained the lead and edged away under urging. MO'S LIL' INDIAN was hustled to the front, set pressured pace outside winner, continued two wide, battled briefly into the lane and in upper stretch but was outfinished. RAYMANJJOHNSONJR content to lag back early, chased inside, made steady progress along the fence, found clear path inside in the stretch and rallied along the rail to gain third. WHYA DA WHYA bumped with winner at the start, moved up along the rail, checked momentarily nearing the turn, dropped back bit then came off the fence and was outgamed for third. KAYAKITYAK settled off the pace, chased three wide to the turn, came out further leaving the bend and failed to threaten. PISTOU was washy going to the gate, stalked from off the fence, continued three wide then outside rival and weakened some in the stretch. CUSTOM CONTINENTAL was prominent early while coming in some, chased two wide then dropped back from between horses.
