WYLIE N WYATT set the early pace while under pressure from the inside, cleared foe around the bend, lugged out into the stretch, then recovered and drew away down the lane. SENATOR MATTY pressed the speed from the inside into the turn, continued to battle into the stretch but was no match for the winner down the lane. ALPINE NUGGET broke in and bumped foe at the start, advanced down the backstretch but lacked room entering the turn, then finished evenly late. BRIDGE TOO FAR reserved in the early going, took the turn three wide and showed a mild response when asked. QUOTED bumped start, saved ground near the rail and never threatened. SAILABLE stalked the early speed from the outside, traveled five wide into the stretch and weakened. SHINTARO well placed behind the early speed down the backstretch, went four wide into the lane, then faded in the stretch.
