CAR LADY left the gate running, quickly took over the rail and drew off, then maintained the advantage through the drive under only hand urging. EYES CREAM could only chase the winner home from two wide. DEVIL GIRL saved ground on the turn, then angled out a bit and got through two wide between to take the show money just past the sixteenth marker. BEST IN THE STORM made a mild stretch gain after a two or three wide trip. ROYALETTE gave chase to the winner from near the rail but then had little to rally on coming down the lane. SIBERIAN SNOW was not a factor. KIANA'S STAR proved no threat four wide.
