Footnotes

OUR JUKE BOX HERO was sent up inside to engage rival, dueled inside into and around the turn, roused entering the lane then quickly shook free and proved best. PRINCIPESCO was slow into stride, shifted in early, chased from the inside, advanced and loomed in upper stretch, could not go with the winner but gamely held second. FORD ISLAND settled off the leaders, angled in some, found the fence, remained inside, advanced some in the lane but was denied the place. EL NAVIGANTE showed good early foot, contested the pace outside the winner, under asking to remain close nearing the stretch, then quickly lost contact and weakened. RICKY EL CORREDOR was off slow, trailed early from the inside, swung out four wide leaving the turn and only passed tiring foes. SANTOMAS was bumped at the start, chased early from off the rail, checked off heels nearing the turn, dropped back and weakened late. WARREN'S SANJAYA broke in and bumped inside rival, stalked early from the outside, came in slightly approaching the turn, angled in some and also weakened.
