**Footnotes**

GET OFF THE SUGAR stalked the early pace setters, angled in around the turn, then came out at the top of the lane, then closed fast for the victory. BALANCE THE SCORE dueled while three deep early on, cleared foe in the upper stretch but was caught late. CITY LIGHTS settled off the pace, saved ground along the rail, then rallied late to gain the show. ANOTHER BOB dueled from along the inside for command, then weakened late. POINTE BIRDS settled off the pace, took the turn two wide, then failed to rally when asked. DIXIE'S RULER was never a factor. WORLD WAR raced up close to the lead while between rivals, then faded out of contention.
