SALLY'S BLADE was forced out and bumped in opening strides, recovered and prompted the pace outside rival, continued two wide into the lane then wore down leader late under steady right hand urging. SOUVENIR SUMMER sped to the front while crossing over, controlled the pace from the inside, dug in when challenged but could not hold off winner in game effort. AHH LOVER settled off the pace and off the fence, stalked three wide, drifted out further entering the stretch and cleared for third. CRIMINAL INTENTION broke in bit then was bumped, settled well off the pace, angled out, chased five wide around the turn and into the lane and improved placing. COMMERCE KID was off bit slow then squeezed back and forced to steady in initial strides, angled in some, chased from the inside thereafter and was no factor. C. R. FESS veered out leaving the gate and bumped rival, showed brief early speed, dropped back inside and weakened. SHARON'S LEGACY broke out and bumped foe then steadied, reserved off the leaders, angled in some and was no threat. CAYOKE WINE was bumped at the break, settled well off the fence then outside foe, chased four wide around the turn and was outrun.
