MIDNIGHT CABINET off slow, hustled down the backstretch, surged clear around the turn, widened advantage, then weakened but was able to hold on. RINCEWIND tracked in the early going, angled four wide around the turn, then flew late but was unable to reach the winner. FRIENDLY HALF broke out, showed no early speed, raced five wide into the stretch, then closed with a rush in the late stages. SWISS ALPINE chased the early speed from along the inside, traveled along the rail through the turn, then railed to rally when needed. MARSHAL LUCKY settled off the pace, took the turn three wide, then failed to respond when roused. KAYAKITYAK saved ground along the rail and was never a factor. GOING PLACES sped clear down the backstretch, raced three wide around the bend, and faded quickly in the stretch.
