Footnotes

YANKEE MINISTER off a bit slow to begin, rushed up and vied for the lead from the inside, cleared leaving the turn, inched away into the stretch, weakened late but held safely. JEFFERY'S PRIDE reserved in the early stages, raced along the rail into and around the bend, closed well but could not get to the winner. BROTHER ERNIE vied between rivals into the stretch and weakened down the lane. UNCLE BEV vied three deep down the backstretch, continued off the rail around the bend, lost contact with the leader leaving the turn, then weakened in the stretch. SACRED GHOST hard to load prior to the start, raced near the back of the pack early, took the turn two wide and proved no menace. FLEET IRON showed no early speed, was off the rail through the turn and never threatened.
