SPANISH GYPSY was hustled along to duel for the lead from the inside with GINA Z, disposed of that rival nearing the three-sixteenths marker and drew off. POMONA LISA veered out soon after the start, was straightened away to save ground into the lane and finished willingly. PASHMINA PRINCESS lacked early foot, saved ground into the stretch and showed some late run. PROUD AND LUCKY was never far back, raced wide into the stretch and finished evenly. GINA Z broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way after three furlongs. TRU BRIDE was pushed into rival soon after the start and failed to threaten thereafter. CONFUSED TONI was never far back, raced wide into the lane and weakened in the drive. NOOROOMA showed no early foot, raced wide into the stretch and failed to menace. FLYING REGINA was bumped and steadied nearing the seven sixteenths pole and did not reach contention.
