**Footnotes**

ATLANTRA'S TANTRUM dueled for the lead from the outside into and around the bend, then powered away in the stretch. GET OFF THE SUGAR chased the leaders from the far outside into the turn, went three wide into the stretch, then outfinished NATIONWIDE FAMILY for second. NATIONWIDE FAMILY also chased the leaders but from along the inside, raced two wide into the stretch and was outfinished for second. PRIDE OF WILSHIRE unhurried in the early going, went three wide into the lane and never rallied. HARGILL dueled with the winner from the inside into the stretch and gave way. FLEET IRON raced at the back of the field, was located a bit off the rail on the turn and proved.
