### Footnotes

SPOT OF SALT settled early inside, made steady progress along the rail, reached the front in upper stretch and inside GET OFF THE SUGAR, edged away and held under strong hand urging. GET OFF THE SUGAR emerged from between horses to grab brief early lead, dueled into rival into and around the turn, between rivals entering the stretch, relinquished control but fought gamely outside winner to the wire. HARGILL forced then dueled outside rival into the turn, continued battle outside rival around the bend, caught three deep leaving the turn and yielded in the final sixteenth. BRIDGE TOO FAR was in bit tight leaving the chute, reserved off the pace while angling to the inside, saved ground into the lane, came out slightly and was clearly best of others. SAILABLE was widest of all chasing the early pace, three abreast from the outside leaving the backstretch, continued five then six wide into the lane and was no factor. SHINTARO outside rival early, raced three wide around the turn, came out further and weakened. SENATOR MATTY between foes into the turn, caught four then five wide into the stretch and also weakened.
