Footnotes

SLOKKIE crossed over and dueled inside rival, gained lead into the turn, edged away then padded that margin from the inside and comfortably held. CHIEF'S LAKE was forwardly placed from the inside, saved ground into the stretch, came out bit and whittled gap on winner late. WHY KNOT US broke out bit, settled outside foe, chased two wide then drifted out slightly leaving the turn and was outfinished for the place. SEAFIRE hugged the rail throughout and was along late for minor award. RUN OVER YOU was antsy in the gate then broke step slow and was squeezed in opening strides, trailed early and was never a factor. DR. TONG was off alertly, dueled then forced the pace outside winner, lost contact and retreated in the final sixteenth. VADERATOR reserved while slightly off the fence, raced two then three wide into the stretch and failed to make any late impact. THUNDER ONE settled well off the fence, lugged out around the turn and was also outrun.
