DANCING JEANNIE forced the early pace outside rival, bid alongside that foe on the turn, gained lead then edged away and just lasted under urging. MISSILETTE bumped with inside rival early,. unhurried from the outside, chased three then four wide into the stretch, roused and rallied strongly from the outside but just ran out of ground. WARREN'S CARLIE tracked leaders from the inside into and around the turn, came out slightly in upper stretch, was steered back to the rail nearing sixteenth marker and loomed late from along the fence. I SMELL VICTORY rushed up inside to grab the lead, set the pace from the inside, came out slightly entering the lane, resisted when challenged but yielded in the drive. CARAT FOR C. C. settled outside foe, dropped back some around the turn, came three wide into the lane, angled out slightly and finished with interest. CELENA reserved early, shifted over, chased inside, advanced into the lane, in tight and force to steady sharply off heels of WARREN'S CARLIE passing sixteenth marker, dropped back then came out and still finished willingly. GLASS OF RED bumped with runner-up early, angled over while trailing, came two wide into the lane and was no threat. Following a stewards' inquiry, WARREN'S CARLIE was disqualified and placed sixth for coming in and impeding the path of CELENA at the sixteenth marker.
