Footnotes

AMERIMARINA controlled the pace early, raced clear while in the two path entering the stretch, was asked by the rider and powered away in the lane. NEVER AFRAID tracked the speed three deep, angled in and made a mild bid around the turn, flattened in the stretch but held second. SISTER VOE reserved in the beginning, saved ground into the lane and improved improved position. PINING PLAY tracked from between rivals, steadied briefly entering the turn, raced three wide into the lane and couldn't rally. GRANDMA TRACTOR chased the pace from the inside, steadied into the turn, then failed to rally in the stretch. PURDY MISS BIRDIE hopped and was off slow at the start, took the turn two wide, came out entering the stretch and never threatened.
