Footnotes

WYLIE N WYATT bumped twice with outside rival early, stalked from the inside, roused the rallied along the rail, found clear path inside pacesetter, reached front in deep stretch and inched away. INDIAN WARRIOR prompted the early pace, continued three wide then outside eventual winner on the turn, angled out some in upper stretch and closed strongly outside to gained second. ROYAL GRAY exchanged bumps with winner early, rushed up along the rail to grab command, edged away on the turn, was slightly off the fence in the lane then overtaken nearing the wire then lost the place. RITZVILLE briefly dueled from between horses then taken off the pace, stalked on two wide path then re-rallied in the late stages and finished gamely from between foes. AT LAST A WILDCAT dropped well back early, saved ground into the stretch, shifted out and found his best stride late. RAPALLO broke alertly then settled off the pace, chased three then four wide into the stretch and lacked any response. The rider of INDIAN WARRIOR claimed found against the winner for alleged bumping on the turn but the stewards ruled there was no contact and disallowed the foul claim.
