TOKAYANA WAY broke out then quickly recovered and stepped to the front, set pressured pace, drifted out some leaving the turn, resisted challenged and edged away under urging. SCREEN QUEEN settled off the pace and well off the rail, chased on four wide path into the stretch, responded from the far outside and closed strongly to gain place. MY NANA LAVANA forced the early pace outside winner, bid alongside that foe nearing the stretch, was forced out some exiting the turn and gave ground grudgingly late. DEMI MARIE pressed the pace early from between foes, was taken off the leaders and shifted to the rail then weakened late in the drive. CURLEY MO was bumped from between foes at the start, chased from between foes into the turn, then lugged out and lacked any rally. COUNTER QUICK hesitated at the start to be off behind the field, rushed up from the inside, continued to save ground into lane but had little left late. SALSA DANCE broke inward and bumped rival, settled from the far outside, later shifted to the rail but was no factor. KAURI CLIFFS broke out and bumped foe, angled in early chasing the pace, saved ground but never menaced.
