Footnotes

LONELY STREET vied for command two wide down the backstretch, angled over to the rail on the turn, cleared foes into the stretch, then held safely under mild urging. WARREN'S CONCEPT bumped both sides at the start, saved ground into the lane, then rallied along the rail and gained the place. EASY CITY broke in and bumped foe at the start, showed early speed, chased from the inside into the turn, angled out into the lane, then went evenly late. CRISTALANO bumped at the start, settled off the pace, angled out around the bend, then finished willingly in the stretch. THREE POINTER unhurried in the early going, angled out on the turn, then improved position in the lane. MEMBER OFTHE TRIBE vied for the lead while three deep off the fence, lost contact with the leader entering the stretch and weakened down the lane. BADGETT CAT vied for the lead from between rivals into the turn, lost ground on the bend, then weakened in the late stages. BAR J F KAFWAIN showed early speed, chased five wide into the stretch and faded.
