JANETOR bumped at the start but quickly sped clear of the field down the backstretch, angled in to take the rail, dueled briefly with outside challenger around the bend, then kicked clear and powered away under right handed urging. FTG. TOO BOLD chased the speed into the turn, bid from the outside around the bend, then failed to sustain the bid and flattened but was still a clear second. ROCKET MAN JACK broke out and bumped foe at the start, reserved down the backstretch, took the turn two wide, then showed a mild response to gain third. EXCESSIVE PRIDE settled off the pace, raced along the inside, angled out around the bend, then failed to rally in the stretch. BOOMERANG LOU showed no early speed, saved ground into the lane and proved no menace. GLOBAL COURT tracked the leader from the two path early on, angled over to the inside on the turn, then weakened down the lane.
