### Footnotes

LAKE OSCEOLA stalked the leader while three wide into the turn, bid four wide entering the stretch, then closed strongly to prove best late. SUDDEN QUEST pressed the pace down the backstretch, bid from the outside around the bend, gained the lead entering the stretch, then finished well but was outkicked by the winner. PIC O DREAM tracked the speed from the two path into and around the bend, then finished willingly for a clear third. OUR LITTLE KITTY settled off the pace on the backstretch, raced two to three wide on the bend, then showed a mild response when asked. LORENBRAY chased just off the speed from the inside, then failed to produce a bid late. STORM FLEUR raced at the back off the field, traveled off the rail into the stretch and never threatened. R. C. STORM set a pressured pace into the turn, took control of the rail position, then gave way in the stretch.
