RICHER GEAR was bit reluctant to load, moved up to join leaders while four abreast, battled outside foe then grabbed lead, bumped with inside rival into the lane, edged away and stubbornly held. FOR CONTRAST dueled then forced the early pace from between foes, angled in and stalked inside, shifted back out leaving the turn, rallied and loomed outside winner but was turned back. TURNAGAIN TAYLOR dueled three deep and between early then battled inside winner, dropped back bit on the turn, came out and bumped that rival into the stretch and weakened. PREMIER YANK settled early from between foes, chased two wide, shifted out and caught four wide into the lane and failed to menace. EL SUVESITO R. D. was outrun early from off the rail, later angled in some, found the rail and passed tiring foes. TRUE TO SUMMING dueled then forced the early issue from the inside, fell back around the turn and weakened. EL SENOR HALO angled in early, chased three wide into the turn, was fanned five wide into the stretch then weakened, failed to return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. HIGHLY UNUSUAL close up early then stalked from bit off the rail, chased three then four wide and weakened. WHY KNOT US bobbled leaving the gate, reserved from well off the rail, raced four then five wide to the stretch and also faded. The rider of TURNAGAIN TAYLOR claimed foul against the winner for alleged interference into the stretch but the stewards ruled that the videotape failed to uphold the claim of foul.
