SUSHIWOOD dueled early from along the rail, shook free leaving the backstretch, came out some and powered away under steady hand pressure. QUIET LIGHTNING contested the early issue while three deep, drifted out some early on the turn, was fanned four wide exiting the bend, responded from the outside and was gamely along for second. FOUL PLAY broke out, stalked leaders while angling in some, remained inside into the lane then on two wide path in the drive and gained third. ROB'S AFLEET reserved while outside foe, shifted in, found the rail, continued inside in the stretch and finished willingly. SAFEONTHEWIRE lagged back early from off the rail, chased three then four wide into the lane and improved placing. MOLLY'S DURANGO contested the early pace from between horses, dropped back some, drifted out into the lane and lost placing from between foes. VIA TAHOE stalked from outside rival, chased two then three wide to the stretch and lacked needed rally from between horses late.
