Footnotes

DELLA'S VALENTINE broke alertly and sped to the front while crossing over, maintained cushion into the lane and proved best under steady urging. SOLO CONTESA bumped at the start, recovered and tracked pacesetter into turn, remained on two wide path and closed gap slightly on winner late in strong effort. STORMY INFERNO settled off the pace then between foes, chased outside rival, remained on same path and bested others. TRACK MAJESTY was forwardly placed from the inside, saved ground chasing the pace and finished evenly. COCINA was bumped and squeezed leaving the gate, unhurried from well off the rail, chased four then three wide and also went evenly late. MY FAVORITE SONGH broke inward and bumped rival, settled off the rail, chased three then two wide into the lane and lacked needed rally. A SONG AT TWILIGHT chased early from the inside, shifted off the fence on the turn, lugged out in upper stretch and failed to menace. JANS FACT reserved from well off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, found the fence, remained inside and was no factor.
