IRON KATY was off alertly then taken off the pace, shifted over, steadily advanced, collared leader inside sixteenth marker and edged away. PERFECT JEB was hustled to the front, set pace inside, resisted when briefly challenged, regained control into the lane but could not hold off winner late. TIKOLINO was steered off rail early, moved up, briefly engaged pacesetter, lugged out badly around the turn, remained well off the rail and held for third. MSTY ALY angled over, chased from inside, swung back out some into the lane, came back inward, rallied and just missed third. HOUSE OF CRYSTAL was slow into stride, trailed from off the rail early, angled in some on the turn, swung back out and was no threat. CHICKS RULE settled off the leaders, shifted over, remained inside and weakened. GALE SCHOONOVER reserved while taken out early, chased three then four wide to the stretch and was never a serious factor.
