FRONT PAGE DANCER chased the speed into the turn, bid from the outside and cleared rival, then powered away in the stretch. WINE N MAXINE sped clear and controlled the pace, drifted out around the turn and was overtaken, then failed to rally but held the place. BEST GIRL EVER raced near the middle of the field, took the turn two wide and never rallied. CEE CALLY DANCE showed no early speed, took the turn two wide and proved no menace. SWIFT STORM raced near the middle of the pack, traveled along the inside to the stretch and weakened.
