Footnotes

CRUZ'N KITTY showed early speed and raced inside the leaders into the turn, headed the leaders around the bend, then dueled down the lane with FIVE STAR CRUISE and inched away in the final strides. FIVE STAR CRUISE raced in close to the pace down the backstretch while between rivals, gained the lead entering the stretch, then dueled through the lane but was outfinished by the winner. REDS WILDFIRE veered out at the start, dueled for the lead while five wide, lost the advantage on the turn while still wide, then weakened in the stretch. CATZDAILYDICTATION dueled for the early lead while four wide into the turn, lost contact with the front-runners around the bend, traveled three wide into the lane and weakened. SASSY BRITCHES chased just behind the early speedsters while three wide off the fence, angled over to the rail on the bend, then failed to respond when needed. SUGAR ROCKS was eased into the stretch and vanned off.
