Footnotes

MILANO CONNECTION dueled from the inside, gained advantage on the turn, edged away in upper stretch while slightly off the rail and prevailed under strong hand urging. GOLDEN AUGUSTO contested the early issue while outside winner, forced pace into the lane, lost contact in upper stretch and safely held the place. ARGYLL LAD was bumped by outside rival shortly after the start, forced inward then bumped by inside rival, recovered and prompted the pace from the outside, continued on three wide path into the lane and was a game third. NUCLEAR MISSILE lagged back early, trailed while slightly off the fence, lugged out around the turn, came four wide into the stretch, then lugged out further nearing the wire. RICKY EL CORREDOR hopped slightly in slow start, chased from along the rail, later came out some and never threatened. LUCKY FITZ broke in and bumped rival, settled outside, chased five wide into and around the turn and was never a factor. COUSIN CLAYTON was bumped shortly after the start, stalked from the inside, lost contact around the bend and weakened.
