SUSHIWOOD stumbled leaving the gate, shifted out and advanced three wide under urging around the turn, bumped with ALPINE NUGGET entering the lane and again in upper stretch, recovered and powered past inside rivals while under mild hand pressure and proved much best while in hand nearing the wire. KENNETH'S WARRIOR settled outside foe, advanced three wide into the lane, loomed from between horses and inside winner in deep stretch and gamely got up for the place. AFLEET RIVER was sent up to engage rival, dueled on two wide path, gained slim lead, edged away in the stretch, was overtaken inside sixteenth marker and lost second late. ALPINE NUGGET settled off the pace, angled over, chased two wide, bumped with winner leaving the turn and again in upper stretch and improved position late. MIDNIGHT EXCESS was off alertly, contested the pace inside foe, lost contact in the drive and weakened from along the rail. DOWNTOWN BANKER reserved early, shifted in some, chased bit off the rail then inside on the turn and lacked needed response. UNCLE JOHN S. lagged back while well off the rail, remained four wide around the turn and was outrun. NATIONWIDE FAMILY was bit fractious in the gate, close up early from the inside, dropped back around the bend and faded.
