COCINA veered out start, stalked the early pacesetter into the turn, gained the lead around the bend, raced four wide nearing the eighth pole, and finished strong under a drive. BAGELS N BONES chased the speed down the backstretch, started to move but lacked room along the inside leaving the turn, then found room and finished gamely for the place. TRACK MAJESTY broke in, bumped start, chased in the early going, traveled three wide into the stretch, then finished evenly and was outfinished for the place. ATA ATAY off slow, bumped start, came out into the stretch and closed well. OURTEQUILASUNRISE veered out start, tracked the early speed down the backstretch, took the turn four wide, then failed to rally when asked. A SONG AT TWILIGHT showed no early speed, raced four wide into the stretch, then passed tired foes. SWISS SPIRIT sped clear and controlled the pace while racing in the two path, overtaken by the winner around the turn, then faded down the lane. AUNT JO ANN chased the the early pace into the turn, went two to three wide around the bend, then faded.
