LONELY STREET under asking early, set the pace while under pressure from both sides, continued to lead with one rival to the outside into the stretch, then dug in late and held gamely to the wire. SINGLE SHOT pressed the pace from the outside into the lane, then finished gamely but was unable to get by the winner. WARREN'S PATRON reserved in the early going, angled three to four wide around the bend, then rallied through the lane and gained the show. EASY CITY chased from off the rail into the stretch, then went evenly late. HELIMARK allowed to settle down the backstretch, raced in the two path around the bend, then traveled willingly through the stretchy. CRISTALANO chased the speed into the turn, raced four to five wide entering the stretch, then failed to summon the needed rally. EL GRAN MATADOR raced near the back of the field, saved ground along the rail and proved no menace. WARREN'S VANWINKLE pressed the pace from the inside into turn, lost contact with the winner around the bend and faded in the stretch. RODEOTIME settled off the pace, raced off the rail into the drive and had nothing left when asked.
