FOXY OLE' broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and drew off through the lane. VERMONT MISS was hustled along to duel for the lead from the inside, could not stay with the winner in the drive but held on well to be second best. SCARLETT STORY was never far back while saving ground early and failed to gain late. BLONDAGE raced off the rail throughout and finished evenly. GUMMY DELIGHT lacked early foot, raced wide into the stretch and showed some late run. SUMMERTIME ROBIN was away alertly to chase the leaders from off the rail and steadily gave way. ULTIMATE PRIZE showed no early speed, saved ground into the lane and failed to threaten. GOODBYESISTERDISCO was off slow, hustled along and weakened. SUPERGET hopped at the start, raced wide into the stretch and did not rally. MIZ REVENGE saved ground to no avail.
