Footnotes

CLEARLY QUIET broke alertly and quickly sped clear while crossing over, responded when challenged on the turn and proved best under urging. DINNER AT JAKE'S content to lag back from the inside, chased on two wide path, split rivals in upper stretch, angled out bit and was along for second. NO CAPS NO FLOORS was slow into stride, between foes early then chased on two wide path, advanced some into the lane, continued inside but was collared late for the place. FIRSTSATURDAYINMAY had good early foot, tracked the pacesetter while bit off the fence, moved up, loomed outside that rival, continued three wide and weakened bit from between horses late. EL GATO GUAPO stalked early from along the rail, dropped back into and around the turn and lacked any late response. ECHO WEST chased outside, caught three deep nearing the turn, came four wide into the lane and never menaced. JUST CHARMED settled between rivals, chased two wide, came out bit into the lane and also failed to threaten. MEDIA MAKER unhurried while well off the rail early, four wide into the turn, came in some around the bend and was never a factor. WHYA DA WHYA stalked early pace, chased three wide around the turn and into the lane then weakened.
