UNIQUE EFFORT bumped at the start and again early with rivals on both sides, recovered and stalked pace from the outside, continued four wide, rallied from the outside and nailed inside leader late. SAN DARINO forced the early issue, moved up and bid outside leader on the turn, battled into the stretch, gained advantage, inched away but could not hold off winner. BRIDGE TOO FAR bumped at the start, gained prominent position between horses, stalked three wide into the stretch and gained the show. LAS VEGAS LUCKY sped to the front while shifting over, resisted when challenged on the turn, dueled into the lane but yielded ground late in the drive and lost the show. I LOVE RACING prominent early, dropped back bit, angled over, gained the rail on the turn then finished with interest. OWNERS MANUAL settled off the pace and bit off the fence, chased two wide, saved ground into the stretch and finished with interest. FIRST SYMPHONY unhurried from the inside, continued along the fence and failed to reach contention. FLYING BILL bumped at the start and again early with the winner, chased well off the rail, dropped back on the turn and gave way in the lane. FREEDOM CLASS lagged back from the inside, saved ground but gave way readily in the lane, pulled up shortly after the wire while in distress and was vanned off.
