Footnotes

PREPPY PILOT steadily advanced from off the rail, reeled in pacesetter on the turn, gained lead then powered away in late going. TRINNI was hustled to the front, dictated the pace from the inside, collared entering the stretch, briefly resisted but was outfinished. LORD MACHO reserved from between foes, chased three wide around the turn, came in bit inside sixteenth marker and was along outside for third. EXCESSIVE DANGER prompted the early issue, angled in nearing the stretch, came out slightly inside sixteenth marker and lost show late. SANGER SHADOW saved ground chasing the pace, came off the rail entering the lane, was in bit tight from between rivals inside sixteenth marker and lacked needed late punch. MAJESTIC AMERICAN widest of all into the turn, later angled in, secured the rail and never menaced. EL JACAL reserved while three deep and between foes, continued on same path and lacked any late response. DUNSTER chased the leaders early from between rivals, caught four wide around the turn and into the stretch and was no threat. The stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the incident through the stretch run, but made no change ruling the incident did not affect the order of finish.
