SOLO CONTESA bumped at the start but recovered and sped to the front, set pressured pace outside rival, edged away into and around the turn and proved best under steady handling. KISKATINAW settled well off the fence, chased five wide early, came in bit around turn, continued bit wide and rallied strongly to get up for second. ROLL MODEL was washy going to the gate, bumped with winner at the break, tracked leaders while three wide, lost contact on the bend and lost the place in final strides. TRACK MAJESTY taken off the pace while coming in some, chased on two wide path, shifted back out in upper stretch and finished evenly. CATLEDO rushed up inside to pressured pacesetter, dropped back bit on the turn and weakened in the drive. A SONG AT TWILIGHT reserved off the pace, angled over, chased while slightly off the rail and lacked needed response. JOY TO THE MOON was void of early foot, saved ground but trailed throughout.
