RAY'S STORM bumped start, reserved down the backstretch, angled out around the bend, then closed fast to win going away. JANETOR sped clear and set the pace into the turn, continued clear into the stretch, then went gamely late but was caught by the winner. SHADY VOTES chased from along the rail into the lane, then finished willingly late. SENOR NAVA broke in and bumped foe at the start, traveled near the back of the field early on, took the turn four wide, then showed a mild rally to advance. FREEDOM GENERAL tracked just off the speed, raced near the inside, then angled out and failed to rally. INDIAN GAMING chased from off the rail into the stretch and weakened. GANNICUS pinballed at the break, showed no early speed, saved ground into the lane and never threatened.
