Footnotes

DOWNTOWN BANKER forced the pace from between horses then inside rival, continued two wide into the lane, hooked up in stretch battle and got the best of the bobs on the wire. ECHO WEST flashed good early foot, set pressured pace on three wide path, battled outside winner through the lane and lost decision on the wire. DINNER AT JAKE'S content to lag back early, chased while slightly off the rail, came two wide then between foes, rallied in the stretch and closed gap on top pair while drifting out some late. TRULY A DELIGHT stalked while outside foe early, chased two then three wide into the lane and went willingly to the wire. DOUBLE POP settled well off the rail, chased three wide around the turn, came in further in the lane and improved placing. CRESPO gradually angled over early, chased four wide around the bend and into the lane and finished evenly. STILORGAN was off bit slow then rushed up inside to prompt the pace, dropped back around the turn and faded from along the rail. T. W. 'S TANK was off awkwardly and dropped well back in early going, chased while bit wide and was outrun. EL JACAL settled outside, chased four wide to the turn, dropped back around the bend and gave way.
