BIG CITY SLICKER bumped with outside foe leaving the gate, recovered the sped to short lead, dueled or set pressured pace inside, came out bit and held sway under urging. BEV'S EX dueled or forced the pace from outside rival throughout, fought gamely in the drive but was denied outside the winner. WYLIE N WYATT tucked in behind dueling leaders, tracked top pair from the inside into the stretch and went willingly to the finish. JUST CHARMED settled off the pace, chased three then four wide to the stretch and finished strongly from the outside. AHH LOVER settled off the pace, chased outside rival then between horses, came out bit and failed to threaten. GRAND TOPPER bumped at the start, reserved early, chased well off the fence then four wide and lacked needed late punch. SMOKIN MOTION settled inside, continued along the rail, saved ground throughout and was outrun. LET ME FINISH was void of early foot, trailed into the turn, broke down later on the bend and was vanned off.
