FREE DIME TRICK forced the early issue from the inside, then stalked the leaders, angled out, advanced four wide, challenged three deep in upper stretch, gained lead and held sway. JUST CHARMED was off alertly, angled in and forced the pace, in tight along the rail and steadied off heels off pacesetter, came back out, re-rallied, bid between foes in the drive and went very gamely to the wire. THE ROBSTER rushed up from the outside to gain command, gradually shifted over, set pace inside, resisted briefly in the drive then weakened. MAKE IT A COUGAR was bumped by inside rival and slow to begin, chased two wide, came three wide into the lane and bested rest. SOUVENIR SUMMER between foes early, tracked leaders from off the rail then outside winner, angled five wide leaving the turn, remained wide and was no threat. WARREN'S PRANCER broke out and bumped rival, chased from the inside, came off the rail in the lane but never menaced. MI MARINO settled well off the fence, trailed three wide to the turn, remained on same path and was outrun.
