**Footnotes**

SEAFIRE unhurried early, saved ground trailing the leaders, roused approaching the stretch, rallied strongly along the rail and nailed leaders late. SERIOUS FORM dueled from between horses then forced the pace on two then three wide path into the lane, rallied outside leaders, poked nose in front for one jump inside sixteenth marker but was no match for winner late. DR. TONG contested the pace from the inside, gained advantage then inched away while slightly off the rail, dug in through the drive but yielded in final sixteenth. ALPHONSO threw his head in opening strides then bumped with outside rival early, briefly dueled then stalked from off the rail, came four wide into the lane and was also outfinished. SOMETHING SONIC bumped with inside rival early, briefly dueled from the outside then also stalked while four then five wide into the stretch and lacked needed late response. BRIDGE TOO FAR angled over early, tracked the leaders from the inside, lugged out around the turn then gave way readily in the stretch, was pulled up just past the wire and vanned off.
