WARREN'S HOT STUFF showed good early speed, set pace outside rival, shook free into and around the turn, continued on two wide path and proved much best under steady late handling. HIGH VALLEY GUY stalked from the inside, hugged the rail into the stretch and kicked clear for the place. AHH LOVER settled off the pace and outside runner-up, remained on two wide path most of the way and was along late for third. SWEET SENOR forced the pace early inside winner, dropped back into and around the bend, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. SWISS SWEEPSTAKES close up early from the outside, raced four then five wide to the stretch and lacked any rally. SMOKIN MOJO prominently placed early, remained off the rail, chased three wide then between horses and also weakened. ETHIOPIAN broke out some, settled off the pace, chased three wide then drifted out in the stretch. LYON COUNTY KING was off step slow then crowded, trailed from well off the fence, continued either four or five wide and was also outrun.
