Footnotes

BIG G'S DANCE dueled for the lead from the inside, shook free from rival on the turn, then drew off under urging. WARREN'S PATRON tracked off the pace down the backstretch, raced four wide into the lane, then finished willingly to obtain second. RAY'S STORM settled off the speed, raced along the inside, then angled out into the stretch and went evenly late. GENERAL BEE LUCKY bumped at the start, in close to leader early while three wide, then five wide into the lane and weakened. GOLD SILVER bumped at the start, was located in the middle of field, raced seven wide nearing the eighth pole, then lacked the needed rally to advance. SENOR NAVA broke in and bumped foes to both sides at the start, took the turn six to seven wide and improved position in the drive. FREEDOM GENERAL showed no early speed, saved ground into the stretch and proved no menace. BALLADERO dueled with the winner while along the inside, then lost contact around the turn and faded in the stretch. HELIMARK chased the early leaders into the turn, went four wide into the lane and faded readily.
