Footnotes

DIXIE HAWKS hooked up in prolonged duel outside rival, came three wide into the lane, inched away approaching the wire and gamely prevailed despite drifting out. CUVEE BLUSH was bit antsy in the gate, showed good early foot, contested the pace inside winner into the stretch, came out slightly and yielded grudgingly late. JOYFUL CREATOR bumped at the start, settled slightly off the rail, chased three wide then rallied outside rival to gain third. SEATTLEINSPIRATION bumped at the start, prominently placed early while outside rival, stalked from the inside, gained rail in the lane and lost the show. TRIBAL MAGIC close up early then dropped back, chased along the inside thereafter and finished evenly. SOUTHERN SUGAH settled from off the rail and outside foe, angled over nearing the bend, checked momentarily passing quarter marker and lacked any response. HARD EIGHT reserved early, also angled in some, later found the fence and lacked any rally.
