Footnotes

THAT CLOSE got shuffled back a bit early, then wisely settled off the pace, moved into a four wide position on the turn, then was sent to call on INTUITIVE MISS at the same time SPRING DAISY bolted, took a narrow advantage from the former at the sixteenth and drove to the win. INTUITIVE MISS was sent up to vie for the lead with SPRING DAISY but began to bear out as that rival bolted, then dug in for the drive when challenged by THAT CLOSE but was outfinished inside the sixteenth pole. GIN N' TYCHONIC raced within easy striking distance three wide around the turn, then moved up to challenge entering the stretch but was impeded sharply by INTUITIVE MISS, checked hard and moved to the inside without making a further bid. SPRING DAISY was sent for the lead two wide but was getting out on the turn and then bolted upon entering the stretch. NANCYS MAGIC BRUSH made no rally during a three wide trip. ROYALETTE was not a threat racing near the rail. BRITE F X stumbled badly leaving the gate and lost her jockey. The stewards hung the inquiry sign immediately after the race in order to review two incidents in the race. First, it was determined that BRITE F X was not interfered with and lost her rider on her own accord. Secondly, INTUITIVE MISS was disqualified from second to third for interfering with GIN N' TYCHONIC entering the stretch.
